Located in north eastern Victoria, features of the Alpine National Park include:

- ❖ Victoria's highest peaks – Mt. Bogong, Mt. Feathertop, Mt. Nelse and Mt. Fainter
- ❖ Rare and threatened flora and fauna species
- ❖ Magnificent Alpine Ash forests
- ❖ Coloured twisted trunks of the Snowgums
- ❖ Alpine herb fields and snowgrass plains
- ❖ Snow covered landscapes
- ❖ Profusion of wildflowers in summer
- ❖ Historic cattlemen huts
- ❖ Great photography ..... we could go on forever!
